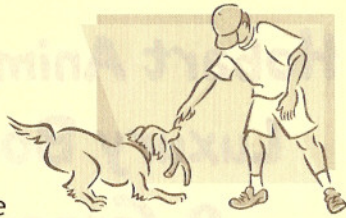


Welcome to Hobart Animal Clinic Luxury Boarding & Grooming "Your Pet's Home Away From Home"

We pride ourselves in treating your pet with the same care and love that we treat our own. Our boarding services include maintaining the cleanest living quarters possible. Your pet is provided with several opportunities to exercise, play or "potty" in our enclosed, spacious, private outdoor runs each day. Extra "special" services are available for your pet as well. We also make sure your pet has fresh water several times a day. All rooms come complete with comfortable beds and our staff maintains strict hygienic standards to promote the healthful atmosphere that you deserve and desire. We want your pet's stay with us to be a wonderful experience both for your pet as well as yourself.

We have several optional services for your dog(s) while he/she "vacations" with us. Please take the time to note which activities you wish your dog(s) to receive while in our care. The cost for these optional services is listed below.



Leash walks outdoors three times daily
(Additional \$2.00/day)

"TLC" time
(Additional \$2.00/day/interval)

Application of flea medication prior to pet going home
(Additional \$3.00)

NOTE: For dogs "TLC" time is a 15-30 minute playtime in an area to run and includes indoor and/or outdoor playing, brushing, special treats, and one on one time with our caring staff.

Standard Boarding Rates:

Theme Room Suite — \$32.50 Each room is spacious, nicely decorated, has music, Cybervision and a TV. We provide a comfortable bed, you are welcome to bring your own bedding or special blanket. You are also welcome to "peek" in on your pet 24 hours a day through our Cybervision set up.

Large Cabin — The basic kennel for a larger breed dog. (\$18 per night)

Medium Cabin — The basic kennel for a medium or small size dog. (\$16 per night)

Small Cabin — The basic kennel for a medium or small size dog. (\$14 per night)

Indoor Run Suites — (\$22 per night)

Presidential Suite — Beautifully decorated, large 12' X 24' room with natural sunlight, couch, soft bed and 24/7 cybervision. (\$70 per night for 2 dog/\$20 each additional dog)

Kitty-Kondo — Perfect for any discriminating feline. (\$15 per night) Multiple units available for \$5 additional per extra unit/per night.

Kitty Cottage — The basic in kitty comfort. (\$12 per night)

Vaccination Policy for all Lodging and Grooming Clients



For the health and welfare of all of our canine and feline guests, owners must supply Hobart Animal Clinic, Luxury Boarding & Grooming with one of the following before we can accommodate your pet.

1. Veterinarian receipt documenting ALL proper vaccinations have been received

2. Faxed copy of veterinarian receipt showing ALL vaccinations are current
3. Telephone verification of ALL current vaccinations from pet's veterinarian

If this information is not provided, is not current, or if the BORDETELLA vaccination has not been received 7 days prior to your pet's visit, we will not be able to accommodate you at this time.

The following are required by Hobart Animal Clinic & Luxury Boarding:

CANINE:

Distemper/Parvo Combination - yearly vaccine or titer

Rabies - yearly or three year vaccine

Bordetella - yearly - This vaccination must be given at least 7 days prior to pet's visit to ensure maximum protection.

Leptospirosis

NO VACCINATION - NO SERVICE

Hobart Animal Clinic Feline Boarding Information

Your cat(s) annual vaccinations and stool sample evaluation are required to be up to date (with proof if not performed at Hobart Animal Clinic). If the vaccinations and stool sample evaluation are not current, we will bring your cat(s) up to date on these items. We also require that your pet is flea free. If fleas are noted, we will treat your cat at your expense.

We have plenty of toys, bedding, bowls, etc. for your pets while they stay with us. We would prefer that you not leave any of your pet's personal items with us unless necessary. We cannot assume responsibility for any items should they be misplaced or damaged. All leashes and collars should remain with the owner.
